End of Season Cleanup

To allow for the reconstruction of the ski racks to better fit new shaped skis and snowboards, and to allow a tidy up of abandoned equipment now cluttering up the change room and vestibule, it is necessary to temporarily remove all the ski equipment now being stored at the lodge and ultimately to dispose of unclaimed items. The Board has decided on the following procedures to allow for this while giving members a reasonable opportunity to remove their gear

(1) Members are asked to remove all ski equipment from the lodge (and private locks from ski racks) during this year;

(2) Any gear remaining by 31 December 2008 will be removed from the change room and vestibule and into a temporary storage area in the lodge, where it will be kept for one more year;

(3) Any gear remaining in the temporary storage area by 31 December 2009, the owner of which cannot be readily identified, will be disposed of in a manner of the Board's choosing.

For the purposes of step 2, any locks remaining on the ski racks at 31 December 2008 will be cut open and removed.

Over next summer, the ski racks will be removed and replaced with better designed versions. Members will be consulted about the design and placement of these.

The above procedures will also apply to any soft items (eg ski boots and clothes) which are not being kept in member's private lockers. These provide nests for rats and mice and are a health hazard and fire risk.

The Board requests members' assistance in our endeavour to clean up and redesign the ski storage facilities for the benefit of all members.

Work parties

Work party dates are not yet arranged, and it will be necessary to work around construction activity on the roads again this year.

Please contact Tony Slatyer, the maintenance officer, if you want to be informed about upcoming work parties and consulted about attendance. Tony will contact everyone who has registered their interest a couple of weeks before each work party to advise what is to be done and finalise attendance.
