## Deck Replacement Program

Plans to replace the deck at the front of the Lodge are advancing. We are in the process of seeking approval from the NPWS for plans and we have a builder able to do the work.

At the time of the AGM, members were advised that the cost to replace the deck and install a north facing window in the mezzanine could result in a levy exceeding \$1000 per membership.

I am happy to tell you that the club will be contributing \$10,000 from reserves and the expected cost will be less than \$1000 per membership. The exact figure is somewhat uncertain until the approval process is complete and we have a final quote from the builder.
